CRAFT

SUMMARY:

This week's craft will illustrate all of the I Am statements as a wrap-up on this series for @HOME groups! It will show all of the I Am statements that Jesus made, as well as where to find them in Scripture.

SUPPLIES:

- Markers, colored crayons, colored pencils
- I Am Template (2 pages)
- A metal brad

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Color the first page of the template provided.
- Then cut out both circles.
- Use the brad to push through the middle and then flatten the brad to hold the two circles together.

ALTERNATE CRAFT/ACTIVITY:

This week we've included a coloring page for the kids in your group who do not wish to do the craft or need something extra!

SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

Split into as many groups as you can with the number of leaders you have or parents, if you are doing this at home with your children discuss these questions as a family:

- What do you think living with Jesus forever will look like?
- What would have happened if Jesus didn't rise from the dead?
- What does it mean to be spiritually dead?
- Have you ever felt you were a mistake or not valuable?
- What difference does Jesus' resurrection make in your life?

PRAYER TIME

This week we are asking kids to think about anyone they know who doesn't know Jesus as their Lord and Savior. Write down the names of those people and then take turns praying over those names!

FAITHINKIDS RESURREC-TION AND LIFE DEPICTION

• FaithInKids Resurrection and Life Depiction: In this 4 minute video, you'll see the story of Lazarus illustrated from John 11. If time allows, share this video with your group to further illustrate Jesus' statement that He is the resurrection and the life.

GAME I:

20 QUESTIONS!

20 Questions is the name of the first game! This game can be played with any size group. The leader should be either Mary, Martha, Lazarus, Jesus, Abraham, or Isaac and should pick that person. Then the kids should ask questions to try to narrow down who the character is (for younger kids you can give a hint that you are someone from the Old Testament Story or from John 11!) They can ask things like "Are you a boy or girl?" Only yes/no questions should be asked! See if your group can guess in under 20 questions!

GAME 2:

SECRET DANCER!

This is just a silly game to get kids up and moving! Set up the group to stand in a circle, and choose one player to be the detective. Send the detective outside of the room. When the detective has left the room, choose a player to be the "secret dancer." They will need to pick a dance move and everyone will then start copying them. When everyone is dancing, the detective is called back into the room and has three guesses to choose who the original dancer is. To make things interesting, the secret dancer then needs to change dance moves and everyone needs to change with them. This allows the detective to discover the secret dancer. Play several rounds of this as time allows!
