CRAFT

SUMMARY:

This week's craft will illustrate all of the I Am statements as a wrap-up on this series for @HOME families! It will show all of the I Am statements that Jesus made, as well as where to find them in Scripture.

SUPPLIES:

- Markers, colored crayons, colored pencils
- I Am Template (2 pages)
- A metal brad

INSTRUCTIONS:
