## Covenants

- 1. What is a covenant?
  - A written expression group values, expectations and /or behaviors which group members hold themselves mutually accountable
  - Biblical examples:
    - Genesis 12 and 15- Covenant between God and Abram for a great nation and offspring that number like the stars (notice it isn't already a reality, but a vision)
    - 1 Samuel 18:3 Covenant of friendship and loyalty between David and Jonathan
    - Hebrews 8 New covenant because of Jesus
    - 1 Corinthians 11:25 Communion and the bread/cup are covenant renewals
  - 2. Why have a covenant?
    - Getting everyone on the same page expectations
    - Pledge of participation- commitment
    - Purpose and parameters for group life- boundaries
    - Tool for spiritual growth- challenge and accountability
    - Trust building and relationships- community
  - 3. What it contains
    - Purpose statement
    - Logistics
    - Values
  - 4. Steps to making a covenant
    - Provide an overview, goal and purpose of covenant, discussion of values and logistics. Hand out 3 \* 5 cards for people to write out ideas
    - Gather everyone's cards and discuss; look for common ideas and building consensus
    - Leader compiles top values and starts writing draft of covenant to share with group. Keep to 5-7 values
    - Hand out final covenant, everyone agrees to uphold
  - 5. When to revisit covenant
    - Annually to refocus group
    - When needed for a tool of accountability with individual members
    - Periodically to remind group of values
  - 6. Other thoughts:
    - Dream big- have a big vision and purpose for your group
    - Plan with the end in mind- how long will your group last? Will there be a plan in place for how long the group will last? Will new leaders be launched from group?
