## NEXTGEN MINISTRY OVERVIEW

**Our NextGen Ministry's purpose is to know, support, and challenge kids and teens so that they might faithfully follow Jesus in all of life, for all of life.** We do this through a variety of programs, both on Sunday mornings and throughout the week.

At Woodlands we desire to connect people to one another and to Christ through discipleship. That extends into our NextGen Ministry, where we place an emphasis on fostering relationships between students and leaders, often encouraging leaders to advance throughout our programs with their group to maintain and build those relationships.



Our Sunday morning programs include Nursery (ages Birth-3), Elementary Sunday Kids (ages 4K-6<sup>th</sup> Grade), and Unique Needs for any child who struggles with the format of Sunday Kids.

Our primary midweek gathering is NextGen Nite on Wednesdays, with Kids (4K-6<sup>th</sup> Grade) and Teens (7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade).

We also have midweek childcare during classes for moms, and kids classes that take place during our adult class nights.
